Credentialing of delegates

All unions have been given notification of their voting entitlements at the ACTU Congress 2021 in accordance with the ACTU Rules. The Rules specify a formula to determine the number of union votes depending on financial membership and the payment of all outstanding fees and levies.

Unions have also been advised they may nominate their delegates voting rights in accordance with the plural voting provisions of the Rules. A union nominated delegate may exercise one, two, three or four votes. The online system has a record of the weighted votes and these will be allocated accordingly.

Changing delegates

To change a Congress delegate, a "Credentialing Change Notification Form" must be completed by the Secretary of the affiliate (or other authorized officer). Due to the online voting system at Congress 2021, this form must be received by COB Monday 26 July to take effect for all of Congress. Online Voting System

Vero Voting is the voting platform that will be used at Congress 2021. This is separate to the online event platform. If your Union has allocated you voting rights, you will be sent further details and instructions.
